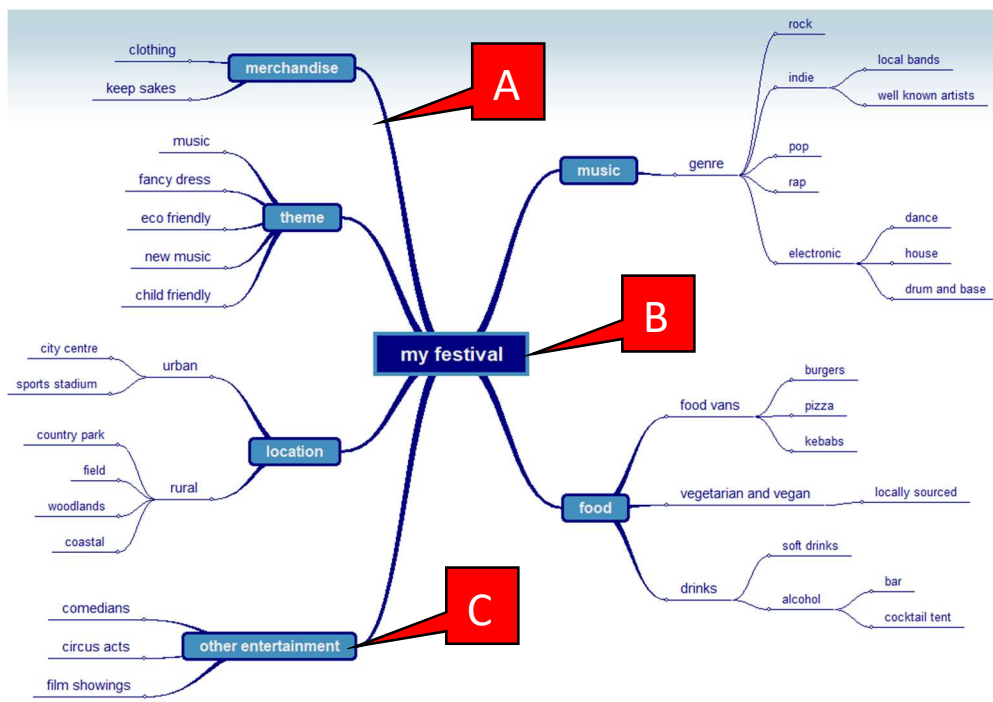

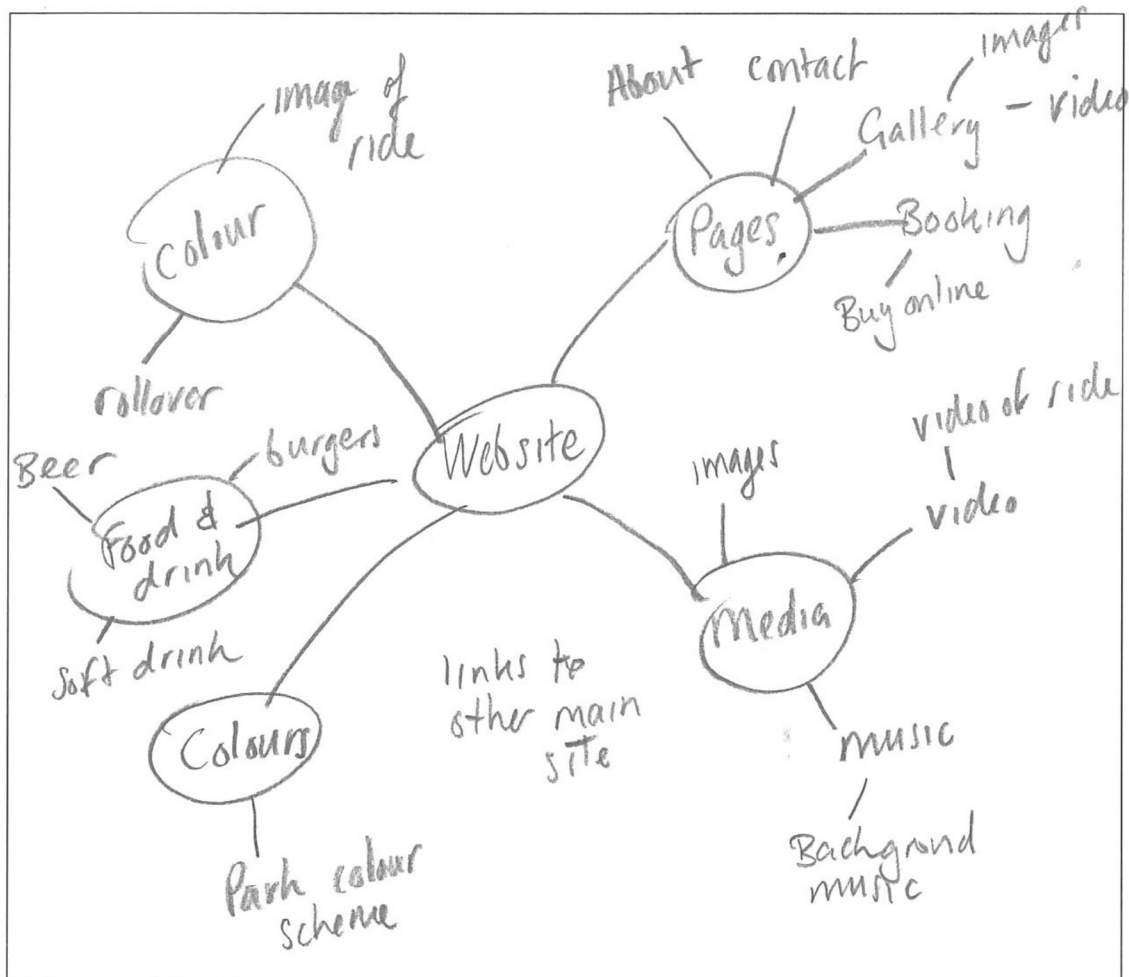
Activity 2.2 – Mark the answer
